He has taught many children's and adult art classes in and out of school settings.

In recent years David has painted many large outdoor across Canada. Many of these murals have cultural and historic significance requiring in-depth research for accuracy. He has found the research to be as challenging as the art process itself. David also works as a Scenic Artists for the television and film industries.
