- All students from kindergarten to Grade 12 are encouraged to participate no matter what your skill level or experience may be.
- Application Fee: No Fee! You are free to enter your artwork.
- Each category will have awards for 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place and honorable mention.
- A “People’s Choice” Award will be selected through public voting
- If you would prefer to not have your artwork judged, then you can submit your work into our non-competitive Juvenile category.
- Artwork will be displayed in the Hall Gallery from March 4 – March 31, 2022.
- Artists are limited to one submission each.

Preparing Artworks for Hanging:

All artwork must be ready to hang upon submission. Artists are required to supply and install 2 screw-in eye hooks for their artwork. Eye hooks should be 1cm in diameter to accommodate the hanging apparatus in our gallery.

Size of Artwork:	Where to Mount the Eyehook
11”x14” or smaller	2” from the top of the artwork, 1 hook on either side
16” x 20” side	3” from the top of the artwork, 1 hook on either
Over 16” x 20”	4” from the top of the artwork, 1 hook on either side

Terms and Conditions:

1. Due to the popularity of this exhibit, each artist is limited to the submission of ONE artwork.
2. Artists must reside in the Southeastern region of Manitoba. The Southeastern region is defined on the North by Highway 44, on the West by Highway 75, on the East by the Ontario border, and on the South by the United States border.
3. All entries must be original works, designed by the artist, preferably executed within the last 2 years, and not previously judged.
4. All artwork must remain with the exhibit for the duration of the show.
5. Upon submission, all artwork must be properly framed or mounted and ready for display.
6. SAC will promote sales of artworks. A 20% commission from all sales will help to support Visual Arts Programs and Exhibits at the Steinbach Cultural Arts Centre.
7. **IMPORTANT:** The Steinbach Cultural Arts Centre and the Steinbach Arts Council assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any entries or exhibits. Private insurance of personal artworks is always recommended - the Centre has limited insurance.
8. Please feel free to contact the SAC staff if you need assistance with preparing your artwork for hanging.
9. Artists must fill out 3 labels prior to submission. Attach one label to back of art; submit other two. Please Note: SAC Staff reserve the right to refuse any artwork that does not meet these conditions for hanging, or that is deemed inappropriate.
