Parents have opportunities during the year to fundraise and volunteer as a way to subsidize their children's classes. If those requirements are not met, then a waiver fee will be charged at the end of the year. We ask that parents either bring in postdated cheques for those payments or fill out a Credit Card Authorization Form before the start of classes. All Credit Card Forms and unused cheques will be shredded at the end of the year.</p>	
<p>Cancellations/Refunds:</p>	<p><i>Full refunds* are given when you withdraw two weeks prior to the start date of a class/workshop. From that point until the start of classes, a 50% credit will be applied to your account upon withdrawal.
